Itinerary

Day 1: Helsinki

Arriving at the airport, the driver will pick-up for private or joint transfer to the hotel. Proceed to the hotel for check in (2 pm – 3 pm onwards). Free and easy with own activity. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 2: Helsinki / Cruise

[B / D]

After breakfast, checkout, group orientation, and head for seasonal activity. Afterwards, proceed with the Orientation Tour of Helsinki to explore the city's landmarks, and picturesque views. Then, free and easy activity at Market Square that is famous for their traditional market foods as well as handicrafts and souvenirs. Next, transfer to port and travel across the Baltic Sea from Helsinki to Stockholm. Check in and dinner onboard the cruise. Enjoy restaurants, shops, entertainment, and wellness activities on board. Overnight in cruise

Seasonal activity:

- **November – March:** Relaxing nature hike in the peace of Finnish clean wild winter forests and discover a glimpse of Lapland on the way to visit a Reindeer Park in Nuuksio National Park. Experience sees reindeers at close range and hear stories about them and while feeding them with lichen, which is their delicacy.
- **April – June:** Admire the main attractions of Finland's crown jewel on the Historical Helsinki route on a Helsinki Archipelago Sightseeing Boat Tour. See famous Unesco World Heritage Sites such as the Fortress of Suomenlinna, enjoy views of the most beautiful neighborhoods of Helsinki, including Eira, Katajanokka, and Kruununhaka, and listen to historical tales of local lore during the tour.
- **July – September:** Relaxing and fun berry picking in the tranquil forest. Experience tasting the picking berries afterward with fresh coffee or tea and snack by the campfire.
- **October:** Mushroom hunting in the tranquil forest. Experience tasting delicious creamy mushroom sandwiches beside an official fire site with coffee/tea.

Day 3: Cruise / Stockholm

After breakfast, check out from the cruise. Driver will pick up and transfer to hotel and leave luggage. Start Orientation City Tour of Stockholm to discover the city's rich history, beautiful architecture, and picturesque landmarks. Then, free and easy activity at Gamla Stan, the Old Town where Stockholm was founded in 1252 and is one of the largest and best-preserved medieval city centers in Europe that is now popular with aficionados of handicrafts, curiosities, and souvenirs along the maze of cobbled streets and colorful 17th- and 18th-century buildings. Later check in the hotel and collect packed food. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 4: Stockholm / Oslo

After breakfast, head to Stockholm's Central Station, then travel to Oslo by train. Once arrive in Oslo Central Station, the driver picked-up for transfer to the hotel. Check in to the hotel before free and easy activity at own leisure. Head back to the hotel at own pace. Collect packed dinner / dinner at hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 5: Oslo / Cruise**[B / D]**

After breakfast, proceed to Holmenkollen and photo-stop at Ski Museum. Then, proceed with Orientation Tour of Oslo. Explore the beautiful Vigeland Park, the largest sculpture park by a single artist in the world. Discover forms of sculptures that depict people engaging in various typically human pursuits, such as wrestling, dancing, hugging and holding hands. Free and easy at own leisure. Later, head to the Port and check in for the cruise. Take a cruise from Oslo to Copenhagen with entertainment, tax free shopping, café, restaurant, bar, and nightclub on board. Enjoy dinner on cruise and overnight

Day 6: Cruise / Copenhagen**[B / D]**

After early breakfast, enjoy the crisp sea breeze on deck while sailing through the Scandinavian waters. Discover stunning sea views of the Swedish and Norwegian coastline, while on the deck. Check out from the cruise. Driver will pick up once at Copenhagen and transfer to hotel for check in. Head for Orientation City Tour with 24 hours Copenhagen City Card. Explore the city's marvellous sights and get a feel of its charming and unique areas. Visit Christiansborg Palace, the largest castle in Scandinavia, to stroll through the Throne Room, where Danish monarchs are crowned. Afterwards, glide along Copenhagen's beautiful, bustling harbour on a canal cruise. Discover a picturesque mix of old and new architecture while listening to entertaining narration of the pass by sight areas. Then, free and easy activity at own leisure. Collect packed dinner / dinner at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 7: Copenhagen / North Zealand / Roskilde / Copenhagen**[B / D]**

After breakfast, proceed to North Zealand. Upon arrival in Helsingør, photo-stop at Kronborg Castle which was the setting of 'Hamlet'. After Kronborg, continue journey through a hilly landscape for photo-stop at the Frederiksborg Castle; the largest Renaissance Castle in Scandinavia. Later, head to Roskilde for free and easy activity before heading back to Copenhagen for Guided Tour of the Freetown Christiania, the autonomous anarchist district in Denmark's capital on the site of a former military barracks. This hippy enclave and alternative community in the heart of Copenhagen is home to many artists and artisans. Enjoy the area's bohemian vibes while hunting for offbeat handicrafts and go for a walk around the lake or stroll down the infamous Pusher Street. Dinner at restaurant. Back to the hotel and overnight.
